Visa Requirements for Tourists

- 01. Original valid passport six (6) months from the date of travel including old passport/s-should have at least two (2) available pages from both sides intended for visa stamping
- 02. Computerized (Arial font, size 12) visa application form, printed in an A4 size paper form to be provided by The Travel Bucket.
- 03. One (1) recent colored passport size photo (with white background, applicant should be in decent attire, colored top with collar and sleeves) that has not been previously submitted to the same embassy where you are currently applying
- 04. Source of income:
 - a. Employed: Certificate of employment stating position tenure of service & with gross annual income-letter should be written in company stationery and contact information of company's HR should be indicated in the certificate
 - b. Self Employed: Copy of DTI Business Registration Certificate with Business/Mayors Permit or SEC Registration Certificate with Articles of Incorporation
- 05. Daily schedule of activities template is provided by The Travel Bucket
- 06. Original bank certification with Three (3) months bank statement, with details below:
 - a. Type of account, current balance, account opening date and the average daily balance
 - b. Original or certified true copy of Three (3) months bank statement or passbook
- 07. Copy of latest Income Tax Return (ITR)
- 08. For foreign national that requires visa to South Korea, a copy of the Immigration Card (ICARD) to establish residency in the Philippines
- 09. Original PSA issued authenticated birth certificate and marriage contract if married.
- 10. For sponsored trip/supported by other person, notarized affidavit of support executed by the sponsor along with the supporting financial documents of the sponsor









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- 08. For foreign national that requires visa to Japan, a copy of the Immigration Card (ICARD) to establish residency in the Philippines
- Original PSA issued authenticated birth certificate and marriage contract if married.
 [Issues within 1 year]
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- 11. Invitation Letter (Describe relationship between Applicant and Inviter in detail) from the invitee
- 12. Residence Certificate (Jumin-hyo) of Inviter and Guarantor Jumin-hyo must describe all household members, without omission of description except Individual Number and Jumin-hyo Code.
- 13. If inviter/guarantor is not Japanese, submit his/her photocopy of Residence Card (both sides)
- 14. Proof of Relationship:
 - **a.** If you are friends, submit photos, E-mails, receipt of remittance or parcel, photocopy of passport including stamps of friend's country, etc.
 - b. If you are relatives, submit Birth Certificate, Marriage Certificate or Koseki-tohon.
- 15. In case that guarantor will shoulder part/all of travel expense:
 - a. Guarantee Letter
 - b. One/some of the Latest Following Documents To show guarantor's precise capability to pay, submission of some of the following is allowed.
 - Income Certificate (Shotoku-shomeisho)
 - Tax Certificate (Nozei-shomeisho. It must include description of the total amount of income.)
 - Photocopy of Final Tax Return Form (Kakutei-shinkokusyo)
 - Bank Certificate









Notes

- 01. For visa applicants with remarks of late registration on their PSA birth certificate, need to submit the original documents such as:
 - a. Baptismal certificate
 - b. Elementary or High School Form 1-37
- 02. For visa applicants with No Record with PSA, need to secure a Certificate of No Record Found issued by the Local Civil Registrar or a live birth certificate issued by the National Archives.
- 03. For visa applicants with unreadable details on their PSA birth certificate and/or PSA issued marriage contract, need to submit a certified true copy of their birth and/or marriage issued by the Local Civil Registrar.
- 04. For visa applicants holding professional licenses (i.e., lawyers, engineers, medical professionals), they have the option to submit a printed copy of IBP ID or PRC ID.
- 05. We will only accept visa applications with complete documents.
- 06. Visa fees and requirements are subject to change without prior notice.
- 07. Once the visa application is filed, your passport will be in the possession of the Embassy, whether locally or internationally. Please ensure that you have no planned travel immediately before, during and immediately after processing.
