

APPLY FOR A U.S. VISA in the Philippines - Nonimmigrant Visas

A nonimmigrant visa is used by tourists, business people, students, or specialty workers who wish to stay for a particular period of time in the United States to accomplish specific purposes. According to U.S. visa laws and regulations, most nonimmigrant visa applicants must demonstrate to the consular officer that they have strong ties to their country of residence and must show that they intend to depart the United States after their temporary stay.

Step 1:

For Nonimmigrant Visa applicants:

Determine your visa type by reading **<u>Common Nonimmigrant Visas</u>**. Each visa type explains the qualifications and application items. Choose the visa type that applies to your situation.

Applicable Visa:

B-1/B-2 visa, you must demonstrate to a consular officer that you qualify for a U.S. visa in accordance with the U.S. Immigration and Nationality Act (INA). Section 214(b) of the INA presumes that every B-1/B-2 applicant is an intending immigrant. You must overcome this legal presumption by showing:

- That the purpose of your trip to the U.S. is for a temporary visit, such as business, pleasure, or medical treatment
- That you plan to remain in the U.S. for a specific, limited period of time
- Evidence of funds to cover your expenses while in the United States
- That you have a residence outside the U.S., as well as other binding social or economic ties, that will ensure your return abroad at the end of your visit


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Requirements:

- 01. A Nonimmigrant Visa Electronic Application (DS-160) Form. (To be advise by The Travel Bucket)
- 02. A passport valid for travel to the United States with a validity date at least six months beyond your intended period of stay in the United States (unless <u>country-specific agreements</u> provide exemptions). If more than one person is included in your passport, each person desiring a visa must submit an application.
- 03. One (1) 2"x2" (5cmx5cm) photograph. Please follow the format below:



- O4. A receipt showing payment of your non-refundable nonimmigrant visa application processing fee, paid in local currency.
 (To be assisted by The Travel Bucket)
- 05. Any supporting document that can be discussed with The Travel Bucket.





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Step 2:

Once you have determined the correct visa type, you must pay the visa fee. The <u>visa fee page</u> lists the visa types and correlating visa fee in US dollars and native currency.

To pay your visa fee, read the <u>Bank and Payment Options</u> page. This page explains how to make your visa fee payment. You must keep your receipt number to book your visa appointment.

The Travel Bucket can assist you with any payment related concerns.

Step 3:

The next step is to complete the <u>DS-160 form</u>. Be sure to read the <u>Guidelines</u> for <u>Completing the DS-160 Form</u> carefully. All information must be correct and accurate. Once the form is submitted, you cannot make any changes. If you need assistance, please consult an immigration lawyer or translator. The call center cannot help you complete your DS-160. You will need your DS-160 number to book your appointment.

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Step 4:

You are almost ready to schedule your visa appointment!

This will start the process for scheduling your appointment. You will need:

- Your passport number
- The receipt number from your Rizal Commercial Banking Corporation (RCBC) or PESONet receipt
- The ten (10) digit barcode number from your DS-160 confirmation page

Ensure that you have provided a valid and correct DS-160 barcode number when you scheduled your appointment. If the barcode number is invalid or incorrect, you will not be admitted to the interview and your receipt will be locked, preventing rebooking, for 30 days.

Step 5:

Visit the <u>U.S. Embassy</u> on the date and time of your visa interview. Be sure to check the <u>Schedule My Appointment</u> page for the necessary documentation needed for your appointment.

You must bring a printed copy of your appointment letter, your DS-160 confirmation page, one photograph taken within the last six months, your current and with previously issued U.S. Visa. Applications without all of these items will not be accepted.

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
